This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving the National Minimum Standards in Reading, Writing and Numeracy in Years 3 & 5
- Implement targeted intervention programs for students who are not reading, writing and numerate at their year level
- Support a holistic approach to student wellbeing to increase student engagement in learning
- Increase student attendance to a minimum of 92%
- Improve teacher capability through focused continuous professional development in the areas of writing and data literacy skills.

Our initiatives include


Initiatives derived from evidence-based research by Robert Marzano, Lyn Sharratt, Michael Fullen and John Hattie:

- Engaging staff in regular analysis of student academic, behaviour and attendance data to provide explicit feedback to students and adjust intervention.
- Connecting individual and small groups of students with targeted social, emotional and wellbeing supports that enable increased engagement and academic outcomes.
- Implementing and reviewing student learning goals throughout all year levels.
- Engaging in quality professional learning in writing, and data literacy practices.
- Monitoring and analysing student attendance on a daily basis, providing explicit feedback to students, families and the community, and targeting intervention accordingly.


Our school will improve student outcomes by

Initiatives	Cost
Purchase an additional Literacy Learning Co-Teacher time	\$45,000
Purchase a fulltime Curriculum Coordinator to develop teacher capacity.	\$75,000
Increase the school's Guidance Officer allocation to 3 days per week.	\$25,000
Increase the school's Speech Language Pathologist allocation to 3 days per week.	\$40,000
Employ an Attendance and Community Officer	\$35,000
Purchase additional Teacher Aide hours for targeted intervention in Prep – Year 2.	\$20,000
TOTAL COST	\$239,967
